

*****OCDA Awards: Volunteer Requirements*****

In order to be eligible to receive an OCDA Schooling Show and/or Recognized Show Award, you must complete 4 hours of volunteering for the club. (*)Volunteer hours are NOT required for bronze, silver, or gold medals, qualified rider pin, or percentage ribbons). Four hours are required for each horse/rider combination.**

There are a variety of ways to fulfill your volunteer requirements. Here are a few suggestions:

- volunteer at an OCDA event – one of our schooling shows, the recognized show in July, a clinic, etc.
- get 2 new people to join OCDA
- get 2 sponsors for either of our schooling shows (sponsor forms available) in April or August (or one sponsor for each schooling show)
- donate a basket that we can raffle off at one of our schooling shows

4. Schooling shows must be OCDA sanctioned. Judges must be USEF/USDF recognized graduates. Schooling shows count toward schooling awards. **A separate form must be submitted for each Horse/Rider combination at each level.** Copies of all tests must be attached to the application.
5. Individuals are responsible for checking the scoring of their tests.
6. Applicants must submit three (3) scores on one horse, riding under three (3) different USEF/USDF recognized judges or "L" graduates, at three (3) different shows.
7. Judge may NOT be your trainer. No more than ONE show from your home barn.
8. **Horse/Rider combinations that have won the championship at a level cannot compete for a high score award again at that level.** However, the winner of the schooling championship is eligible to compete for the USEF championship ribbon at the same level.

5. The USEF championship placings will be awarded to individuals who are competing beyond schooling shows. Scores from any USEF show (including OCDA's) will count. Riders may apply for OCDA schooling awards and USEF awards at the same time as long as all criteria are met.
6. Applicants must submit three (3) scores on one horse, riding under three (3) different USEF/USDF recognized judges at three (3) different shows to qualify for a USEF High Score Award. **Horse/Rider combinations that have won the championship at a level cannot compete again at that level.** (Exception: the winner of the schooling championship is eligible to compete for the USEF championship ribbon at the same level.)
7. Individuals are responsible for checking the scoring of their tests.
